

A Lenten Service Series



During Lent, our church will share a worship series and bible study entitled Christ on Trial. Each week will feature a different guest who will be cross examined by a "prosecutor" seeking to clarify Jesus' guilt or innocence.

Christ most certainly WAS on trial. Two thousand years have come and gone since Caiaphas and Pilate passed judgment on Jesus in Jerusalem. And though the verdict passed down at that trial was a miscarriage of justice, the result fulfilled God's purpose: to save the world by the gift of God's son.

Christ most certainly IS on trial. His presence in the world, his radical teachings all demand a reaction. Every human heart must wrestle with questions like: Who is this Christ? Is he who he claims to be? If so, what does he mean for me and my living? Christ demands a reply. Daily, Christ is on trial.

As he is again this Lent. Scriptural evidence will be analyzed each service, and eye witnesses will share their encounters with Jesus:

- We will hear a lawyer's opening statements as to who this Jesus is, and who will be on the witness stand in the coming weeks.
- Matthew will speak of Jesus' scandalous association with the seedier side of society.
- A former cripple is, herself, evidence of Jesus' loose interpretation of Sabbath law.
- "Jesus, Disturber Of The Peace!" Is it true? Prominent Jewish leader **Nicodemus** weighs in.
- Evidence that Jesus is a self-elected "judge and Jury" is offered by a woman caught in adultery.

Christ On Trial examines evidence that demands a verdict: Who is Jesus...for you?
